

THE POWER OF PLAY IN ACTION

Imagine how it must feel when something as simple as a family outing to a museum isn't simple at all. "Going to places with a high-needs child with autism was very difficult," says Lara. "My child with special needs has a twin and a younger sibling. And we always stuck out."

That changed when Lara discovered LICM. "It was a place where we felt safe—all of us," she says. "There were people around us who looked like us, who sounded like us, and who acted like us."

Long Island Children's Museum offers a wide range of accessibility and inclusion resources. accommodations help children regulate sensory input in overwhelming environments, enabling them to play and learn alongside their peers and allowing families to participate comfortably. For Lara and her family, that expansion of services has been transformative.

"Now that the kids are older, there are fewer things we can do together as a family," Lara says. "But the Museum is still something we can all enjoy. It really grows with the child."
