Session 1: Classes: Mornings – 10 am – 11:30 am

Session 2: Classes: Afternoons – 3:30 pm – 5pm

There is no fee for this program.

Classes will be in English via Zoom.

For the Parents...

A parent or guardian of the child must attend a weekly Zoom workshop for an hour. These workshops are designed to help parents better support their kids in school and will be taught in their native language.
