For families who were educated elsewhere, going to school in the U.S. can be an intimidating experience *for both the child and the parents!*

Together to Kindergarten: A very special readiness program for kids entering Kindergarten. Long Island Children's Museum created this program to smooth the transition into school for immigrant children entering Kindergarten and their families.

Two sessions of ***Together to Kindergarten*** will be offered this summer under a hybrid-learning model: At the museum on Mondays and remote learning via Zoom on Tuesday – Friday mornings.

Session 1: June 28 – July 23, 2021

Orientation: Saturday, June 26 via Zoom

Session 2: July 26 – August 20, 2021

Orientation: Saturday, July 24 via Zoom

There is no fee for this program.

For the Children...

Classes will be taught in English.

Mondays at the Museum: 9 to 11 a.m. (your own transportation)

Tuesday through Friday mornings: 10 a.m. – noon via Zoom.

For the Parents...

A parent or guardian of the child must participate in an hour long mandatory parenting workshop, once a week, via Zoom. These workshops are designed to educate parents on how to better support their kids in school and will be taught in their native language.
