

Impact of COVID-19 to LICM Operations



Here's how COVID-19 has reduced our programming and our people:




LICM Adapts

46,796 Visitors to LICM since reopening September, 2020 — June, 2021

200+ tickets donated to Essential Workers to thank them for their service

Our Cupcakes & Cocktails benefit event, along with grants, sponsorships, and individual donations are essential to keeping our doors open.
