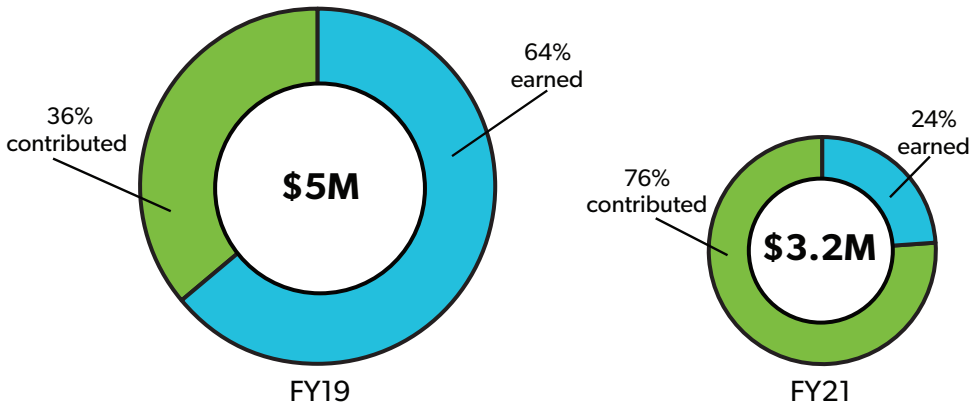
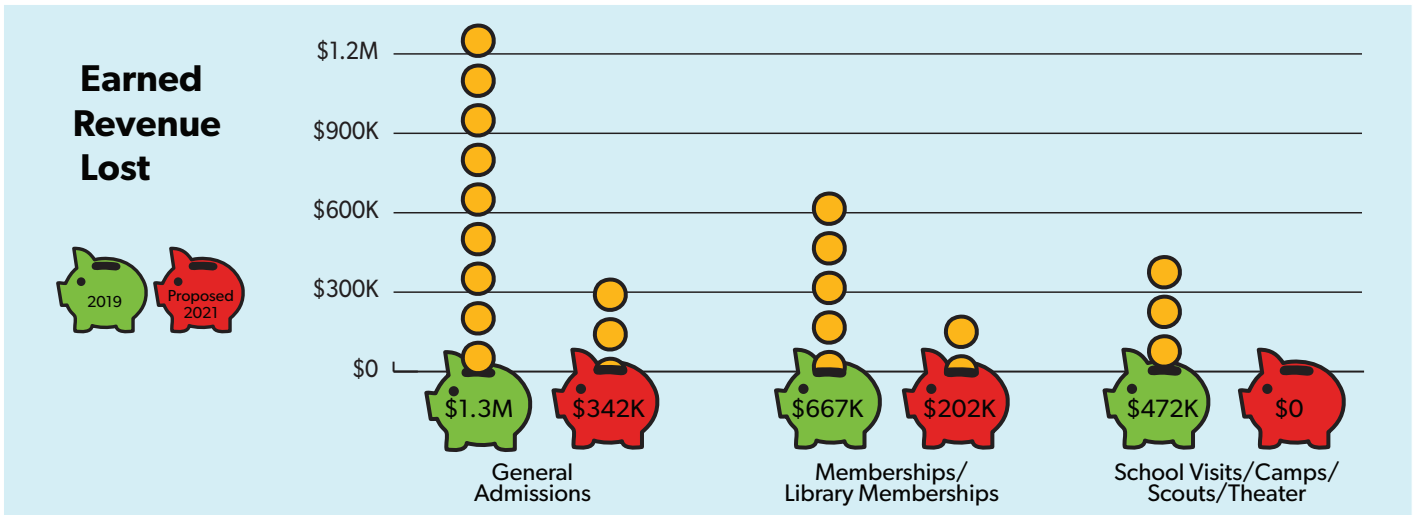


# Impact of COVID-19 to LICM Operations



The budget has shrunk by 36% and the balance between earned and contributed revenue has flipped.

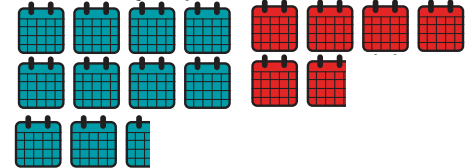


## Here's how COVID-19 has reduced our programming and our people:

## We have re-fit and re-opened the Museum, and welcomed visitors safely, under limited hours and capacity restrictions



**\$50,000** cost to refit Museum with air filters, cleaning products, and other COVID-related items to make Museum safe



**35,000** Visitors to LICM since reopening September, 2020 (as of 4/11/21)



**200+** tickets donated to Essential Workers to thank them for their service
