FROM FIRE TO WATER: A UNIQUE GIFT

LICM partnered with the Shinnecock Nation to add a very special Indigenous artifact to LICM's new permanent exhibit opening this Fall. *Saltwater Stories: We Need the Sea & the Sea Needs Me* will feature a *mishoon* or canoe named "Lil Pine" or "Pewea Koowa", which was burned and dug out this past April on the Shinnecock Tribal ground. Children from the tribe participated in this very special traditional process.

"We truly appreciate LICM honoring our Indigenous culture by also gifting us our very own mishoon for our tribe in the spirit of this community partnership," states Cultural Steward Chenae Bullock. The mishoon arrived on June 30 with a ceremonial presentation honoring Indigenous traditions and is currently on display.

Anastasia Pagonis, a Paralympic swimmer, grew up coming to LICM and was excited to return with her guide dog to view her role in this informative exhibit. LEARN AND PLAY EXPO: A DAY FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Community Care RX and the Long Island Children's Museum proudly partnered to host the first Learn and Play Expo for People with Disabilities on Monday, May 12, **2025,** at Long Island Children's Museum. This special event welcomed families and individuals in residential programs from the disability community for an evening of exploration, play, and connection as part of the Museum's "Community **Connections" partnership efforts** to expand access to vulnerable populations.



Nearly 200 attendees enjoyed free play throughout LICM's 14 interactive exhibits while connecting with 20 human services agencies from across Long Island. These agencies showcased vital support services and community programs for families with individuals of all ages who have intellectual and physical disabilities. Pizza and salad were provided along with drinks generously donated by **Liberty Coca-Cola**. Guests received sensory fidgets to take home.
